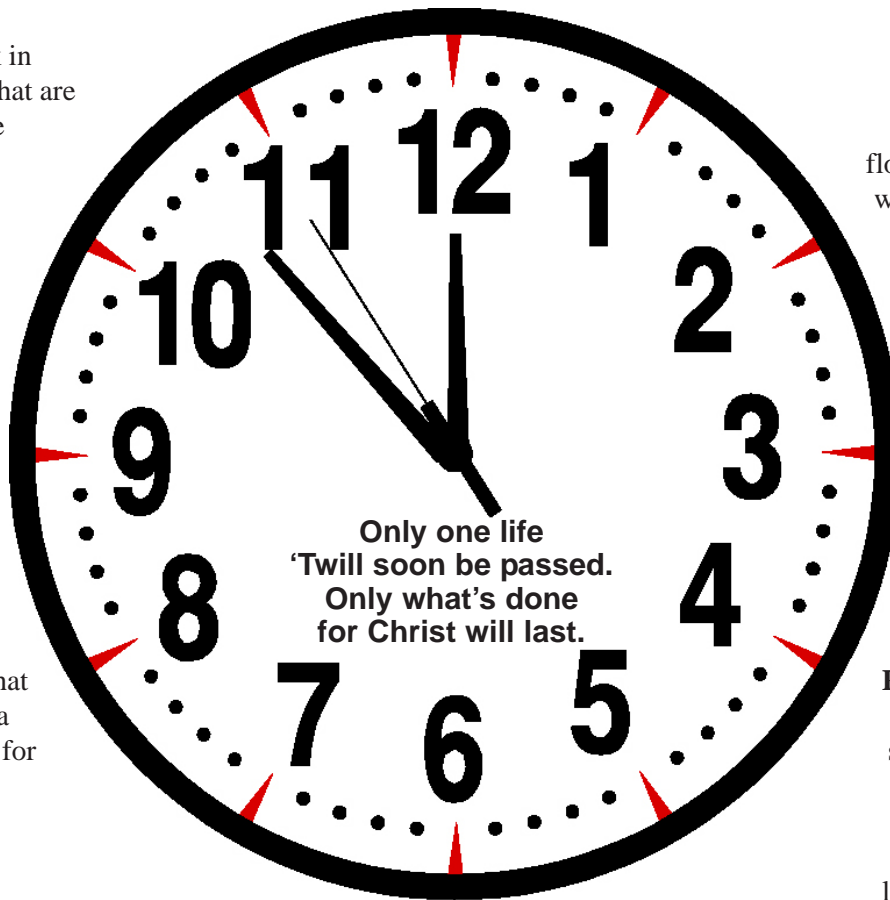


Ephesians 5:15-16, “walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, Redeeming the time ...”
